As a candidate for office, I support the following;

- I am familiar with, respect, and support the US Constitution, the Bill of Rights and the New Hampshire State Constitution, which I view as the highest laws of our country and state.

- I believe in a balanced budget, low spending, limited taxes, the elimination of earmarks and the eradication of the federal deficit.

- I believe that all bills brought before me should be read, fully understood and then vetted against the Constitution [s] before voting for them, to ensure that they do not violate the Constitution, the Rule of Law or the Rights of the People.

- I believe that states can reject any federal mandates or laws that they deem violates their sovereign rights, as enumerated in Article 10 of the U. S. Constitution.

- I believe that the prime function of the federal government is to protect us from enemies within and without, including our national sovereignty, to include the securing of our borders.

- I believe that the United States is a sovereign nation, and that the laws here should reflect traditional American values, and not the values or legal dictum's of other nations or cultures.

- I believe in the right to LIFE, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness for every citizen regardless of race, creed, religion or color and that in pursuit of these, all citizens should be free of excessive taxation, regulation, or confiscation of property.

- I believe in the free market and am against government ownership or excessive control of the airwaves, the internet, or the takeover of private water, land or private businesses.

- I believe that there should be no manipulation of money or markets by private banks and thus support the end of the Federal Reserve.

- I do not believe in interventionist wars, involvement in the civil disputes of other countries, or in nation building, and that the only exception to these are those special and rare circumstances that Congress deems appropriate.

- I believe that the federal government, governor's associations, private foundations, and state NGOs have no right to direct or set educational policy that is paid for by local taxes. All education should be locally controlled and parents have the right to remove their children from government schools at any time.

- I believe the second amendment is sacrosanct and not to be violated by international treaties or other unconstitutional laws that would restrict its intention

- I believe in the right of privacy of every U. S. citizen. I will vote to repeal the Patriot Act, will oppose a National ID Card, or any other system that betrays the medical privacy of ordinary citizens with any attempt to institute a data gathering mechanism.

- I believe in the right to private medical and retirement accounts that are out of the reach of government management.

I will act with honor, integrity, and prudence while in office, and commit no act that will bring shame to me, my office, my state or this nation.
